Position: Warehouse and Distribution Operator (Inventory)
Department: Warehouse
Reports to: Warehouse and Distribution Team Leader

Position purpose:

The primary focus of the Warehouse & Distribution Operator is to perform Warehouse & Distribution functions.

Key responsibilities:

- Performing all receiving functions including import and export loading and unloading, de-vanning.
- Production supply via Kanban & kitting, putting away (in line with FIFO), loading & unloading of trucks and couriers, inventory movements via CSI, administration, accurate and timely communication and/or reporting of non-compliance, safety concerns, quality concerns or general communications across all aspects of warehouse functions, this includes offsite storage or temporary facilities.
- Picking, packing and dispatch of internal and external customer orders.
- Conduct physical cycle counts and inventory audits, investigate, report, and reconcile discrepancies.
- Completing Safety & Quality Assurance checks as required & in line with business expectations.
- Utilizing Enatel's ERP system (CSI) & paperwork available, you must ensure compliance for receiving inwards deliveries, put away stock, maintain transfers and inventory movements, pick & dispatch to internal or external customer orders.
- Maintaining accurate records/ paperwork correctly to ensure controls and checks have been completed and are traceable and stored correctly.
- Maintain internal inventory or external customer labelling in line with business requirements.
- Physical stock movements to ensure warehouse optimization is maintained and FIFO is achieved.
- Forklift & Wave Picker Operations daily to move stock, load & unload
- Maintaining a clean and tidy work area.
- Meeting and exceeding daily operational targets, ensuring effective time management is achieved, whilst ensuring the security of the inventory is maintained.

Other duties:

- Upholds the company values.
- Perform any other tasks as required by your Team Leader and/or the business.
- Contributes to the achievements of department goals and objectives.
- The nature of Enatel's business is such that there can be peaks and troughs of workload in the Warehouse. Therefore, from time-to-time warehouse staff may be requested to assist with factory activities such as assembly work, packing, and other production duties.
